

1) What do you mean by coming together federalism?

Ans) Independent states join together on their own to form a larger unit is known as coming together federalism.

2) What do you mean by holding together federation?

Ans) When a large country chooses to divide its authority between the member states and the central government, federalism is regarded as holding together

3) Define Union list.

Ans) The Union list is a list of subjects of national importance.

These include national defence, foreign affairs, banking, communications and currency. These subjects

are included in this list because there is a need for the formation of a uniform national policy on these issues. The Union Government has exclusive jurisdiction

over subjects included in the union list.

4) Define State list

Ans) It comprises those important subjects on which the state government can pass laws. Subjects like Police, local government, trade and commerce, agriculture within states are included in state list.

5) Define Concurrent list.

Ans) The Concurrent list comprises of the subjects which are of common concern both of

the centre and state government. Ordinary, both the central and the state governments can frame laws on these subjects.

6) Define Residuary list

Ans) Residuary list is the list which contains that do not come under Union list, State list or Concurrent list. These subjects come after the Indian Constitution was made. So, it was not added in any of the initial lists.
