23/9/21 Birds are winged creatures. An Ostrich cannot fly in spite of having wings. Why?

Ans- Ostrich cannot fly because they have very small wings and a heavy body. The small wings are not sufficient to lift the Ostrich's heavy body for a flight. The individual barbules are not interlocked like a flying bird's feather. This means the feathers offer no wind resistance for them to get off the ground. Their flat breastbones lack the keel that anchors the strong pectoral muscles required for flight.
