- ① Nuuk - Capital of Greenland
- ② Godthab - Earlier known as the capital of Greenland.
- ③ Eric the Red - He is the first European who visited Greenland as an explorer called Eric the Red.
- ④ Tundra region - The Arctic circle passes through the southern part of Greenland. Most of Greenland therefore lies in the Frigid zone in the Northern Hemisphere is known as the Tundra region.
- ⑤ Icebergs - Huge pieces of ice frequently break off and float in the sea. They are called icebergs.
- ⑥ Inuit - The Inuit were the original inhabitants of Greenland.

- ① Nomadic - In the past, the Inuit were nomadic, that is, they used to roam around throughout the year to hunt.
- ② Kayaks - They used boats called Kayaks for fishing in the sea.
- ③ Parkas - The people wore clothes made of animal skin and fur. They wear jackets with hoods lined with fur, called parkas.
