Write a sentence about the things you see around you. Use both singular and plural naming words. Begin your sentences with 'I see ...'.

Examples: I see a pen. I see two pencils.

I see a book. I see two books.

I see a brush. I see two brushes.

I see a watch. I see two watches.



Take learners to a place where there is a large number of visual stimuli. For example, a games room, a garden, etc.
Help learners frame simple sentences and talk about the objects in terms of their shape, size, colour, number, etc.
