

COTTAGE INDUSTRIES:

- Also known as village or household industry.
- few people get together, use simple tools and make things for sale.
- work from home.
- Do not use machines.
- Local raw-materials forms finished product for local consumption.
- Encouraged to enable village-based artisans to earn a living by following traditional means of occupation.

- Ex- Toy making, weaving, pottery, shoe making, jewellery making.

SMALL SCALE INDUSTRIES:

- These industries use lesser amount of capital and technology.
- They hire skilled labour.
- Use machines.
- Obtain raw materials from outside.
- Produce more in terms of volume.
- Sell through traders in markets.
- Works under private sector.
- Ex- Silk weaving, garments production, food-leathered units, chemical manufacturing, furniture-fittings, automobile components etc.
