

Q Some people conclude that politics & social decisions should not be allowed to mix. Support this with argument.

A. The statement is true because if we observe social decisions & politics together at first sight :-

- * It would appear that their combination is very explosive & dangerous.
- * Democracy involves competition among various political units / parties. Their competition tends to divide & if they start competing in terms of some existing social divisions, it can make social divisions into conflict political divisions & lead to conflict, violence or even dist. disintegration of a country.
- * In the case of Northern Ireland this region of the united kingdom has been for many yrs the site of violent & bitter ethnopolitical conflict.

All this shows that 'politics' should not be mixed with social divisions.
