



- The area on both side of of Equator, between the Tropic of Cancer and the Tropic of Capricorn, is called the Torrid or Tropical zone.
- The areas that lie between the Tropic of Cancer and the Arctic circle in the North Hemisphere, and the Tropic of Capricorn and Antarctic circle in the Southern Hemisphere, are called the Temperate zones.
- The area between the Arctic circle and the North pole in the Northern Hemisphere, and between the Antarctic circle and South Pole in the Southern Hemisphere receive very little heat from the Sun. They are very cold, and large part are covered with snow throughout the year. They are called the Polar zones or Frigid zone.
