Delhi sultanate

1. The founder of Khalji dynasty was Jalal ud din Khalji.
2. The able general of Alauddin Khalji was Malik Kafur.
3. The first sultan of Delhi Sultanate who extended his kingdom to south was Alauddin Khalji.

5. The poet in Aqaudin Khalij's court was Amisi Khussau.
6. Aqaudin Khalij; was an able and excellent administrator. In order to energise the administrative machinery, he made the following reforms
- He increased the size of army to protect the empire
 - To increase the revenue income he confiscated all sirdar's land holdings.
 - The peasants paid revenue in kind directly to the state.
 - To prevent conspiracies among nobles

he banned all banquets and assemblies.

- He transformed markets of Delhi and set of different markets for different items.
- Weight and measures were checked and grains were stored in godown for the time of need.
