A- antecedents → neighbours.
Referents → theirs

(c) Ayub fell down the stairs as he didn't notice the water on them.

A- antecedents → Ayub
Referents → them

(d) Mugdha and kabir completed the experiment before time as they found it

easy.

A- antecedents → Mugdha, kabir
referents → they, it, which

(e) Jayant said, 'I can win the competition.
It is going to be very interesting.'

A- antecedents → Jayant, competition
referents → I, It

(F) Tarza, can you wrap the gift by yourself
or do you need some help from John? He
is busy decorating the drawing room.

A- antecedents → Tarza, John, room
referents → you, He
