

Q. "The Peace treaty at Versailles was a harsh and humiliating peace. Justify the answer.

Ans- The Peace treaty Versailles with the Allies was a harsh and humiliating peace.

- > Germany lost its overseas colonies, a tenth of its population, 13 percent of its territories, 75% of its iron and 26% of its coal to France, Poland, Denmark and Lithuania.
- > The Allied Powers demilitarized Germany to weaken its power.
- > The war Guilt clause held Germany responsible for the war and damages the Allied Countries suffered.
- > Germany was forced to pay compensation amounting to £6 billion.
- > The Allied armies also occupied the resource-rich Rhineland for much of 1920s.
