In the second category, people are appointed on a long-term basis. This is called permanent executive or civil services. Person working in civil services are called civil servants.

- Q2) Describe the powers of the president.
- All governmental activities take place in the name of the President.
  - All laws & major policy decisions of the government are issued in his/her name.
  - All major appointments are made in the name of the President. These include the appointment of ~~India~~ the Chief Justice of India, the Judges of the Supreme court & High courts of the states, the Governors of states, the Election Commissioner, ambassadors to other countries etc.
  - All international treaties & agreements are made in the name of the President.
  - The President is the supreme commander of the defence force of India.
