We use the pronoun *we* in place of the name of more than one person including ourselves.

## Examples:

State U.S.

Ravi and I are brothers. We go to the same school. Seema and I are sisters. We are from Hyderabad.

• We use the pronoun *they* in place of the name of more than one person. *They* is used to talk about others.

## **Examples:**

Tony and Tina have a pet dog. *They* play with their dog. Amit and Neha live near school. *They* walk to school every day.
