Q → Write some of the adaptations of a camel and a polar bear.

1. Camel

Camel are well adapted for survival in the desert. Their adaptations include: Large, flat feet-to spread their weight on the sand. thick fur on the top of the body for shade, and thin fur elsewhere to allow easy heat loss.

2. polar bear.

A white appearance - as camouflage from prey on the snow and ice. thick layers of fat and fur - for insulation against the cold. They have fat under the skin to be used as food in winter.
