We use the pronoun *we* in place of the name of more than one person including ourselves.

Examples:

•

Ravi and I are brothers. We go to the same school. Seema and I are sisters. We are from Hyderabad.

We use the pronoun *they* in place of the name of more than one person. *They* is used to talk about others.

Examples:

Tony and Tina have a pet dog. They play with their dog. Amit and Neha live near school. They walk to school every day.
