The procession of workers led by Father Gapon reached the Winter Palace it was attacked by the police and soldiers. Over 100 workers were killed about 3000 wounded. Which was called Bloody Sunday.

3. What was Duma?

The elective consultative Parliament ~~or~~ formed after 1905. Revolution was called Duma.

What were the reasons for 1905 Revolution and what was the result of it?

- The year 1904 was a particularly bad one for Russian workers. Prices of essential goods rose so quickly that real wages declined 20%.
 - When four members of the Assembly of Russian workers, were dismissed at the Putilov gun works there was a call for industrial action.
 - Over the next few days over 110,000 workers in St Petersburg went on strike demanding a reduction in the working day to 8hrs, an increase in wages and improvement in working conditions.
 - The procession of workers led by Father Gapon reached the Winter Palace it was attacked by the police and the cossacks. Over 100 workers were killed and 300 wounded. The incident was called Bloody Sunday.
 - All the people like doctors, lawyers, engineers and other middle class workers joined the strike, established the union of unions and demanded a constituent assembly.
- The result of the Revolution was Tsar Nicholas II allowed the creation of elected consultative parliament called Duma.
