Answers

1) Bolshevik Revolution is the revolution that brought down the monarchy in Russia in 1917. On November 6 and 7, 1917 (or October 24 and 25 on the Julian calendar, which is why the event is often referred to as the October Revolution), leftist revolutionaries led by Bolshevik party leader Vladimir Lenin launched a nearly bloodless coup d'état against the Duma's provisional government.

2) Petrograd soviet was a council of workers and soldiers that played a key role in the success of the Russian Revolution of 1917. According to Lenin
