Answers

- 1) The inherent defects of Weimer Republic were :- The system of proportional representation made it difficult for one party to achieve a majority. This lead to a rule by coalitions. Article 48 gave the president the power to impose emergency, suspend civil ~~and~~ rights and rule by decree.
- 2) The Nazi party, officially the National socialist German workers' party was a

far-right political party in Germany active between 1920 and 1945, that created and supported the ideology of Nazism.

3) Article 48 of the constitution of the Weimar Republic of Germany (1919-1933) allowed the president, under certain circumstances, to take emergency measures without the prior consent of the Reichstag. This power was understood to include the promulgation of "emergency decrees".

4) The symbol of the nazis is the swastika, which the newly established Nazi party formally adopted in 1920.
