Ans → After the 1st world war the Germany
forced to sign a treaty to put forward allies
power came to know as Treaty of
Versailles.

The conditions for treaty of Versailles? :

- ① Germany lost its overseas colonies, a tenth of its population, 13% of its territories, 75% of its iron and 26% of its coal to France, Poland, Denmark, Lithuania.
- ② The Allied powers demilitarised to weaken its power.
- ③ The war Guilt clause held Germany responsible for the war and damages the Allied countries suffered.
- ④ Germany was forced to pay compensation amounting to 6 billion.
- ⑤ The Allied armies also occupied the resource rich Rhineland for much of the 1920's.

According to treaty of Versailles the great laws came to Germany. So, it became a humiliating treaty for Germany.
