(Q5) Briefly explain the causes for the revolution of 1905 in Russia?

\* The year ~~1904~~ 1904 was particularly bad one for Russian workers - prices of essential goods rose so quickly that real wages declined by 20 percent.

\* ~~The~~ ~~members~~ of ~~workers~~ ~~associations~~ were ~~more~~ ~~democratic~~.

\* When four members of the Assembly of Russian workers, which had been formed in 1904, were dismissed at the Putilov Iron works, there was a call for industrial action.

\* Over next few days over 110,000 workers in St. Petersburg went on strike demanding a reduction in the working day to eight hours, an increase in wages and improvement in working conditions.

\* When ~~protesters~~ the procession of workers led by Father Gapon reached the winter Palace it was attacked by the police and the Cossacks. Over 100 workers were killed and about 300 wounded. The incident, known as Bloody Sunday, started a series of events that became known as the 1905 Revolution.

\* All the people from different fields such as doctors, students etc. joined the strikes.
