

Q. What are the powers of Prime minister and President of India?

~~The~~ Prime Minister

- * The Prime minister is free to choose ministers, as long as they are members of parliament.
- * He chairs and takes most of the decisions in the Cabinet meetings.
- * He coordinates the work of different departments and his decisions are final in case disagreements between departments.
- * He exercises general supervision of different ministries and all ministers work under his leadership.
- * He distributes and redistributes work to the ministers.
- * He also has the power to dismiss ministers. When the Prime Minister quits, the entire ministry ~~quits~~ quits.

President

All governmental activities take place in the name of the President. All laws and major policy decisions of the government are issued in his name.

All major appointments are made in the name of the President.

All international treaties and agreements are made in the name of the President. The President is the supreme commander of the defence forces of India.
