Communicable Diseases

Non-communicable Diseases

1. Communicable diseases are the diseases which can be passed on from one person to another.

1. Non-communicable diseases are the diseases which does not spread from one person to another

2. They are generally caused by some bacteria, viruses, protozoa.

2. They are generally caused by some nutrient deficiency, allergy etc.

3. Some communicable diseases are malaria, typhoid, common cold, measles etc.

3. Some non-communicable diseases are night blindness, beriberi, rickets, anaemia etc.
