

| 1. Communicable diseases are the diseases which can be passed on from one person to another. | 1. Non-communicable diseases are the diseases which does not spread from one person to another. |
| 2. They are generally caused by some bacteria, viruses, protozoa. | 2. They are generally caused by some nutrient deficiency, allergy etc. |
| 3. Some communicable diseases are Malaria, typhoid, common cold, measles etc. | 3. Some non-communicable diseases are night blindness, beriberi, rickets, anaemia etc. |
