Ans: Maharana Sangram Singh, the King of Mewar and Daulat Khan Lodi, the Governor of Punjab invited Babur to defeat Ibrahim Lodi and invade India.

4) Name two battles which put Babur firmly on the throne of Delhi.

Ans: First battle of Panipat and the battle of Khanua.

5) What was the main source of information about Babur?

Ans: Baburnama - autobiography of Babur.

6) Why did Humayun have to flee from his kingdom? Did he return?

Ans: Sher ~~Shah~~, the governor of Bihar defeated Humayun in the **Battle of Chausa** in 1539 CE. In 1540 CE, Sher Khan dealt Humayun a final blow in the **Battle of Kannauj**. Humayun fled to Sind, and then to Persia, where he remained in exile for 15 years. His son, Akbar, was born during this exile in Sind. In 1555 CE, Humayun made a second attempt to regain Delhi. He captured Lahore, and occupied Delhi and Agra.

Ans: Surji Dynasty
