

1) Difference between communicable and non-communicable diseases

Communicable diseases can be passed from an infected person to a healthy person.

Communicable diseases are spread by microbes or germs called bacteria, protozoa and viruses.

Ex: - Plague, Tuberculosis  
Typhoid

Non-communicable disease.

Non-communicable diseases cannot be passed from an infected person to a healthy person.

Deficiency or the lack of particular minerals causes non-communicable diseases. Ex:- Night blindness, Beri Beri, Rickets, Scurvy, Goitre, Anaemia.
