Q) What is a flower? Draw a typical flower and label its different parts.

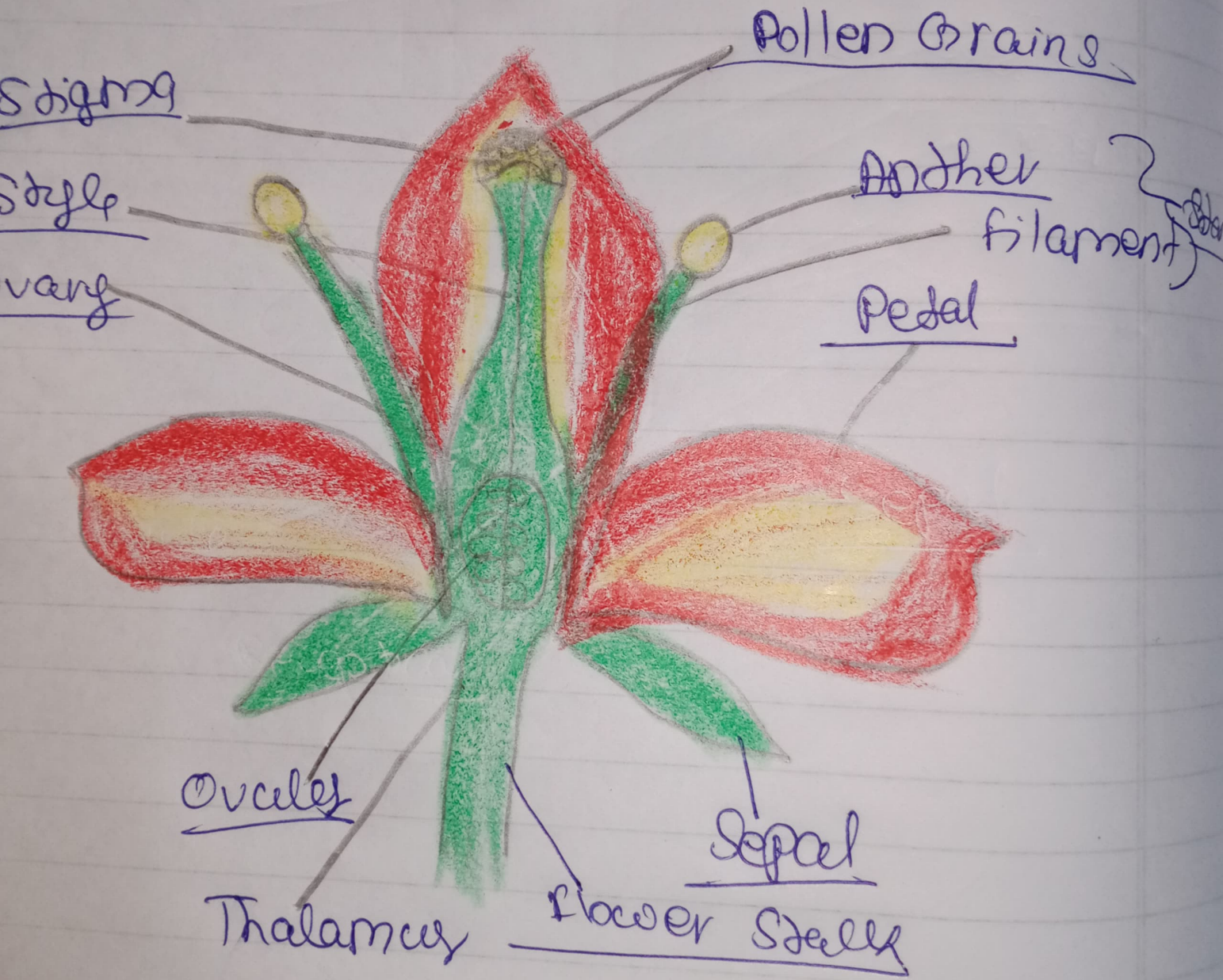
Ans. A flower is the most beautiful and colourful part of a plant which serves as a reproductive organ.

Q) State the location of the following in a flower:

a) Sepals: Sepals are the green outermost part of a flower.

b) Petals: This forms the second inner whorl. Petals are the large, fragrant and brightly coloured parts of the flower.

Diagram of typical flower and label its different parts.





Anthers: It is located in the third whorl of the flower. The filament of the stamen bears the anther at its tip.

Stigma: It is located in the fourth and the innermost whorl of the flower. The style bears the stigma at its tip.
