(d) We had to go to Jubilee Hill. We stood at the bus stand. (Past Continuous, wait)

Ans - We had to go to Jubilee Hill, so we were waiting at the bus stand.

(e) He put the pizza in the oven. After an hour, the kitchen was filled with smoke.

Ans - He had forgotten to take out the pizza from the oven, so the kitchen was filled with smoke.

(f) The police saw the burglar in the evening. They caught him next morning. (Past Perfect Continuous, chase)

Ans - The police had been chasing the burglar since evening, before they caught him the next morning.

(g) Yasmin suggested another movie. She already

knew the story of that movie. (Past Perfect, watch)

Anu Yasmine had already watched that movie, so she suggested another.

(h) As I entered the room, I ~~saw~~ saw that Rhea had paint brusher and a colour palette in her hands. (Past Continuous, paint)

Anu - Rhea was painting when I entered the room.
