ARTERY	VEINS
Involves in carrying oxygenated blood except for pulmonary arteries	Involves in carrying deoxygenated blood except for pulmonary veins
Located deep within the body	Peripherally located close to the skin
Red in colour	Blue in colour.
Carrying blood away from heart to various parts of body	Carrying blood away from different body part to heart
