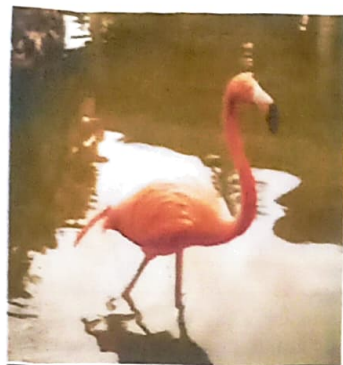

Five migratory birds and details

1) Siberian Cranes

Siberian cranes are snowy white colour birds that migrate during winter to India. These cranes are omnivorous and breeds in the Arctic tundra of Russia and Siberia.

2) Amur Falcon

Amur Falcon are known to breed in South east Siberia and migrate to India over the Arabian sea in winter.

3. Greater Flamingo
