

What do you mean by 'coming together' federations?

Ans:- 'Coming together' Federations is one of the kinds

Ans- OF routes through which federations have been formed. 'Coming together' federations involves independent states coming together to their own to form a bigger unit, so that by sovereignty and retaining identity they can increase their security. In this feder 'coming together' ^{equal} federations all constituents have ^{some} ~~are~~ powers and ^{are} strong vis-à-vis the federal government.
Example:- USA, Switzerland, Australia.

What do you mean by Holding together federalism ?

Ans- 'Holding together' federations are also a kind of routes through which the federations have been formed.

'Holding together' federations is formed when a large country decides to divide its powers between the constituent states and the national government.

In 'Holding together' federations centre is more powerful vis-à-vis states.

In 'Holding together' federations constituent units of federations have unequal powers.

Example)- India, Spain, Belgium.

Define Union list.

Ans:- Union list involves subjects of national importance. Union government ~~and~~ or central government can only make laws. The subjects under Union list are defence, banking, currency, foreign affairs, and communication.

Define State list.

Ans:- State list has subjects of local and state importance. State government alone can make laws. The subjects under state lists are Police, trade, commerce, agriculture and irrigation.

Define Concurrent list.

Ans:- Concurrent list has subjects of common interest both to centre and state. Both the centre and state can frame laws. Concurrent lists includes subjects like education, forest, trade union, marriage, adoption and succession. If the law of state government and central government conflict with each other, the law made by the Union government will prevail.

Define Residuary list.

Ans:- Residuary list or residuary powers includes all subjects which do not fall under the three other lists. Union government alone has the power to make laws.

Example :- Computer Software.
