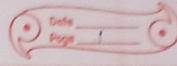

Stem is the main vertical part of the shoot system. The points on the stem from where the leaves and branches originate are called nodes. The part of the stem between two successive nodes is called an internode. The tip of the shoot has buds called ~~and~~ apical buds or terminal buds. They are responsible for the vertical growth of the stem.
