## Rules of adjectives masculine to feminine:

1. Generally, ~~ane~~ ~~e~~ is added to the masculine in order to make an adjective feminine.

ex grande = grande  
haut → haute

2. If the masculine form ends with a ~~e~~, the feminine form will stay same.

ex rouge → rouge  
belge → belge

3. The feminine of certain things ~~adjective~~ is formed by doubling the final consonant of the masculine form & then adding ~~e~~.

ex bas → basse  
bon → bonne

4. Adjectives ending with ~~au~~ in the masculine form change to ~~e~~ to get the feminine form.

ex beau → belle  
nouveau → nouvelle

singular to plural

1. In most of the cases, an adjective is made plural by adding ~~s~~ to its singular.

form

ex large → larges

joli → jolis

2. If an adjective already ends with s there is no change in plural.

ex épais → épais

gris → gris

3. An adjective ending in eau in the singular form by adding x.

ex beau → beaux

nouveau → nouveaux

4. The feminine plural of adjectives is formed by adding on s to the feminine singular form.

ex belle → belles

grise → grises
