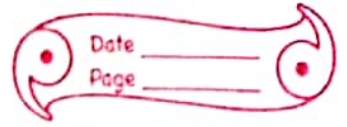

Q1) What do you mean by coming together federalism?

Ans-) Independent states coming together on their own to form a bigger unit, so that by pooling sovereignty and retaining identity they can increase their security. This is called as Coming together federalism. Some such countries are- USA, Switzerland, Australia etc.

Q2) What do you mean by holding together federalism?

Ans-) Large country decides to divide power between its constituent states and the national government. India, Spain and Belgium follow this type of federalisation named as Holding together federalism.

Q3) Define Union List.

Ans-) The type of list which has subject of national importance such as defence of the country, banking, communication, foreign affairs and currency, called as Union List.

Q4) Define State list.

Ans-) The type of lists which has subjects of local and state importance like - Police, trade, commerce, agriculture, irrigation etc., known as the state list.

Q5) Define Concurrent list.

Ans-) The type of list which has subjects of common interest both to the state and centre like education, forest, trade union, marriage, adoption and succession, known as concurrent list.

Q6) Define Residuary list.

Ans) The subjects which do not fall under any of the union, state or concurrent category like computer software are called as Residuary list. The Union government only has the powers to legislate on them.
