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**(b) Smallest number**

Consider the numbers given below :

**48, 30, 42, 25, 50**

To find the smallest number among these, we will arrange them in descending order.

$$50 > 48 > 42 > 30 > \textcircled{25}$$

The last number we get is the smallest number. So 25 is the smallest number here.
