

6.6 Addition of Two 3-digit Numbers

Examples : Solve $175 + 512$.

Step 1: First, add the ones together and write below ones column.
5 ones + 2 ones = 7 ones.

Step 2: Then, add the tens together and write below tens column.
7 tens + 1 tens = 8 tens.

Step 3: Finally, add the hundreds together and write below hundreds column.
1 hundred + 5 hundreds = 6 hundreds.
Answer 687
