Ans:

Bats are different from birds because bats are mammals whose forelimbs form webbed wings, making them the only mammals naturally capable of true and sustained flight. Bats do not flap their entire forelimbs, instead of flapping they spread the wings, which are long and covered with a thin skin. Bats have teeth. Whereas, Birds are characterized by feathers.
