

Babur was the founder of Mughal dynasty. Daulat Khan Lodi invited Babur to invade India. The two battles which put Babur firmly on the throne of Delhi were Battle of Panipat and Battle of Khanua. Sher Khan defeated Humayun in 1540 CE to flee to Sindh and then to Persia where he remained in exile for 15 years. In 1555 CE Humayun made a second attempt to regain Delhi. He captured Lahore and occupied Delhi and Agra.
