Face-to-face informal communication.

Face to face communication occurs when two person starts communication by direct contact. It helps clear and quick understanding of the message. It is an effective way of communication as body language is visible.

Description

E-mail

E-mail can be used to communicate quickly with one or many individuals in various locations using electronic media. It offers flexibility, convenience and low cost.

Notices / Posters

It is an effective way of communication used when the same message has to go out to a large group of people at a same location. E.g. used in schools to provide some information to students.

Business Meetings

Communication during business meetings at an organization are generally addressed to a group of people. It can be related to business, management and organisational decisions.

Other Methods

Example - social networks, message, phone call for communication, newsletter, blog etc.






No pets - sign to avoid entrance of pets generally in restaurants and stores





No parking zone - In front of someone's house or narrow road to avoid traffic jams.




No mobile phone - Generally present in hospitals to avoid disturbances.
