① Who was the leader of Bolshevik party?

ans → Vladimir Lenin.

② What do you mean by Bloody Sunday?

ans → Bloody Sunday was a massacre that took place on 22nd January 1905 in St. Petersburg, where over 100 workers were killed and about 300 wounded when they took out a procession to present an appeal to Tzar.

③ What was Duma?

ans → A Duma is a Russian assembly with advisory or legislative functions.

④ What was the result of the Russian revolution?

ans → The Russian revolution took place in 1917 during the final phase of World War I. It removed Russia from the war, and brought about the transformation of the Russian empire into the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics.
