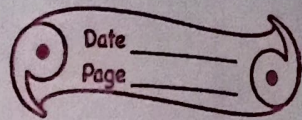

Answers.

1) ans:- MODERATES:- * they are the early nationalists.

- * they wanted self-govt.
- * they are not totally against to the British rule,
- * they believed to adopt the constitutional methods to achieve their objectives.
- * they believed and entrusted the policy of cooperation.

RADICALS:- * they are assertive Nationalist

- * they wanted "SWARAJ" i.e., the Total freedom,
- * they are totally against to the British

rule and wanted to uproot it,
they believe to adopt the Revolutionary
methods to achieve their objective,
They entrusted the policy to Non-cooperation.

s:- firstly, the area of Bengal was too large
and it was difficult for the British to
administer efficiently so
