- A_a) The Earth is spherical in shape.
- A_b) A globe is a miniature form of Earth.
- A_c) The latitudinal value of Tropic of Cancer is $23\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ N.
- A_d) The 3 heat zones of the Earth are:-
- i) The Torrid zone.
 - ii) The Temperate zone.
 - iii) The Frigid zone.
- A_e) Parallels of latitude - The imaginary lines that runs horizontally across the surface of Earth are called parallels of latitude.

Meridians of longitude - The imaginary lines that run vertically across on the surface of the Earth, from north to south pole are called meridians of longitude.

- A_f) The sun is exactly over the head once a year, on all the latitudes between these 2 tropics. The sun rays fall exactly over the head hence the Torrid zone receive the maximum amount of heat.
- A_g) In India, the standard meridian is 2.5° E. So, the time difference between London and India is 82.5×4 , which is 330 mins (5 hrs 30 mins).
