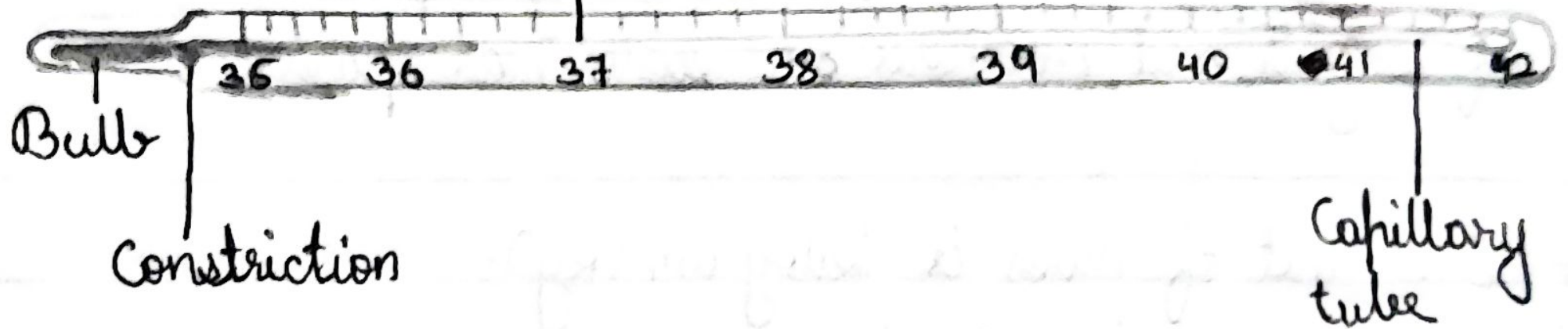


A4. The instrument used for measuring the temperature of human is ^{clinical} thermometer

AS. A clinical thermometer has markings from 35°C to 42°C . It has a slight bend or kink in the stem just above the bulb. This kink is called constriction. This prevents the mercury from falling back all by itself. The temperature of a healthy person is 37°C . This temperature is marked by a red arrow.
