

① Define glands

Ans - A gland is an organ which produces and releases substances that perform a specific function in the body.

② What are the different types of glands? Write two differences between these glands.

Ans - There are two types of gland :-

* Exocrine :- Exocrine glands are salivary glands, Pancreas, etc. They send their secretion through ducts directly to ~~the~~ the target or on the other hand, the endocrine glands are ductless glands.

* Endocrine glands :- The hormone-producing glands are called endocrine glands. Their secretions are called hormones, which are poured directly into the blood and are thus carried to the target organs.
