

Q 1) Define the term constitution?

Ans - A constitution is a set of rules, laws and principles according to which a country is governed. The rules and laws are specially created to suit the needs of the people of that country. People belonging to different ethnic groups, language groups, religions, and cultures make up a nation.

Q 2) What are the organs of the government?

Ans - The three organs of the government are :-

* Legislature

* Executive

Q 3) What is meant by Dissent?

Q 4) What do you mean by Rule of law?
