

**Example :** Subtract 4 from 6.


We write the digits as shown :


$$\begin{array}{r} 6 \\ - 4 \\ \hline 2 \end{array}$$


The difference between 6 and 4 is 2.  $\therefore 6 - 4 = 2$ .
