Revolution & what was it
Ans: The reason of 1905 Revolution was -

* The year 1904 was a particularly bad one for Russian workers. Prices of essential goods rose so quickly that real wages declined 20%.

* When four members of the Assembly of Russian workers were dismissed at the Putilov Iron works, there was a call for industrial action.

* Over the next few days over 1,10,000 workers in St Petersburg went on strike demanding a reduction in the working day to eight hours, an increase in wages & improvement in working conditions.
