



- Rani Lakshmi Bai was the queen of Jhansi and one of the heroes of the 1857 revolution.
- She was born in varanasi
- Tatia tope and Nana Saheb were her childhood friends
- She was educated at home and knew horse riding sword fighting etc.
- She was married to king Gangha Gangadhar Rao Newalkar of Jhansi.
- British annexed her state after the death of the king under the Doctrine of Lapse policy.

- She refused to give her State & decide to fight with the British.
- In March of 1858 British attacked the fort of Jhansi under command of Hugh Ross.
- She died on 18 June 1858 & was buried in Gwalior city.
