Landline telephones are not used as much today as they were 20 years back. Why?

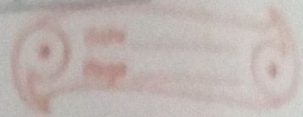
Ans- In the early 21st century, the landline telephone has declined due to the advancement of mobile network technology and the obsolescence of the old copper wire networking.
