


Subtraction


when we remove or take away few things or numbers from a group, we do is '-' (minus).

Subtract by counting backward.

(a)
$$5 - 3$$



(c)
$$7 - 3$$



Example: Subtract 4 from 6.

We write the digits as shown:

- 4

The difference between 6 and 4 is 2. \therefore 6 – 4 = 2.
