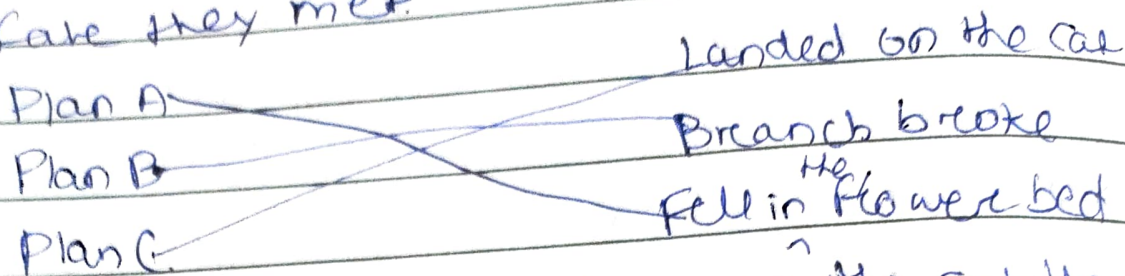


## Gret going
