communications and currency. They are included in this list because we would need a uniform policy on these matters throughout the country.


The union government alone can make laws relating relating to the subjects mentioned in the union list.

4) Define State list?

A) State list contains subjects of state and local importance such as police, trade, commerce, agriculture, and irrigation. The state governments alone can make laws relating to the subjects mentioned in the state list.

5) Define concurrent list?

A) Concurrent list includes subjects of common interest to both the union Government as well as the state government, such as education, forest, trademarks, marriage, adoption and succession. Both the union as well as the state governments can make



laws on the subjects mentioned in this list. If their laws ~~or~~ conflict with each other, the law made by the union government will prevail.
